#### MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

With the development of the pandemic and the spread of new variant viruses in different places, the epidemic situation in various countries is still recurring. Hong Kong is also taking cautious steps to prevent the fifth wave of the pandemic.

The impact on the supply chain is also gradually emerging, such as the extension of the lead time of raw materials; manufacturers still catching up the previous production schedule and undelivered orders, coupled with recent shipping bottlenecks and container shortages, resulting in longer and longer delivery lead time.

Hence, the repeated delays in the delivery lead time is putting much pressure in maintaining the in time supply of goods as well as the turnaround of working capital. Even during the epidemic, the general public has a fundamental demand for health food that can help boost immunity. However, due to the above reasons, the risk of products out of stock and hence hindering capital flow back will be a major challenge for the industry.

Recently, the vaccination rate has increased but is still far away from the target of 70% to 80%. There is still a long way to go before the full recovery of food and beverage, tourism, bars and some entertainment and performance industries.

It is hoped that the health food industry will stick to its position, keep profitable, and continue to provide high-quality health food to consumers, so that the general public will be effectively protected in terms of enhancing immunity and maintaining good health.

# **Strategic and Regulatory Committee Update**

The Trade and Industrial Organisation Support Fund (TSF)

The Hong Kong Health Food Association appointed the Hong Kong Productivity Council as the implementation agent and submitted a revised application to the "The Trade and Industrial Organisation Support Fund" to the Hong Kong Trade and Industry Department in June 2021. The scheme aims "to establish Hong Kong Health Food Knowledge-based Product Information System (HKHFKPIS) for Hong Kong health food industry through smart innovation and to enhance the image of health food in the expanding market in the Greater Bay Area (GBA) through the research and workshops. The first phase of the Hong Kong Health Food Database covers 3,000 to 4,000 health food products information, increasing transparency to the government and consumers. This will benefit not only member companies but also the related industry chains such as pharmacies, retail stores, etc. The Chinese Manufacturers' Association of Hong Kong, Modernized Chinese Medicine International Association, Hong Kong Trade Development Council, The Hong Kong Retail Management Association, and the Hong Kong General Chamber of Pharmacy also support the scheme by being collaborating organizations.

# **External Affairs Committee Update**

## 1. Collaboration and Program participation

The Hong Kong Health Food Association was nominated by the Joyful Mental Health Foundation to participate in the 2020-2021 "Caring Company Recognition Scheme" of the Hong Kong Council of Social Services, and was awarded "Caring Organisation" for the first time.

# 2. "New Smart Anti-counterfeiting Technology Pilot Project" by Hong Kong Productivity Council

The "New Smart Anti-counterfeiting Technology Pilot Project" aims to help Hong Kong's pharmaceutical and health food industries experience the new smart anti-counterfeiting platform technology and the latest printing technology of anti- counterfeiting labels. The pilot plan will adopt a double-layer label design scheme. The top layer code will introduce the anti-counterfeiting query process and project introduction of this pilot plan. The bottom layer anti-counterfeiting code is an effective authenticity query function, comprehensively applying multiple anti-counterfeiting technologies to protect the product brand.

The Hong Kong Health Food Association, as a support organization for the plan, encourages the industry to actively participate in the technical experience, and the plan will not charge any fees. The HKPC project team will select the registered companies according to relevant requirements.

## **Mental Health Message**

Humans are emotional animals. They are born with seven emotions: joy, anger, worry, thought, sadness, fear, and shock, which accompany people throughout their lives.
